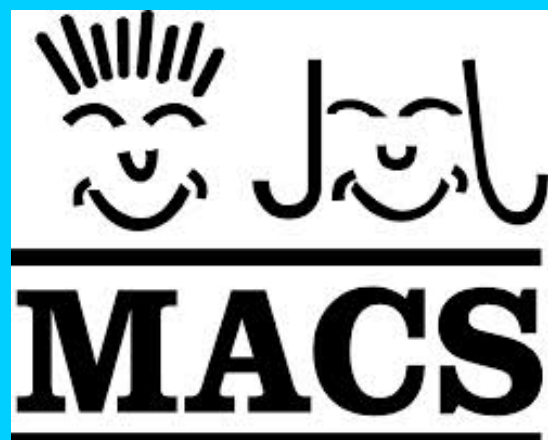
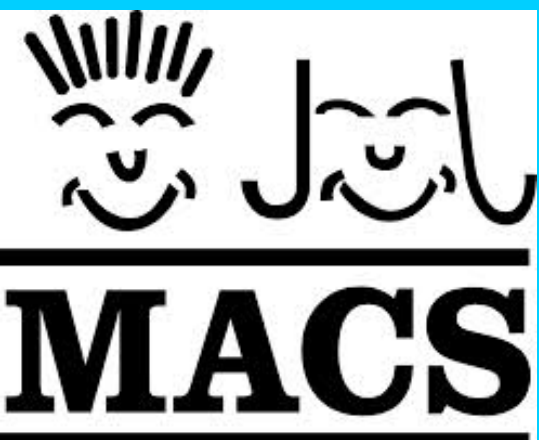
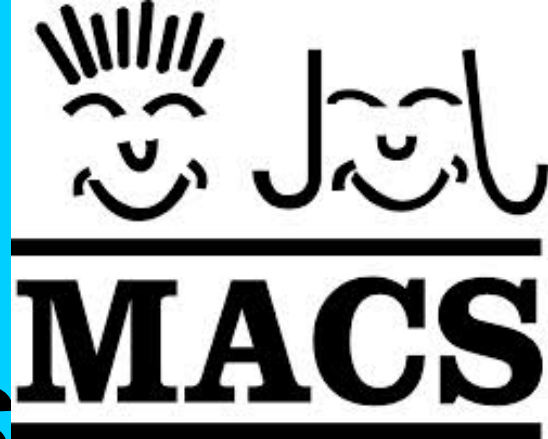

Health and Safety

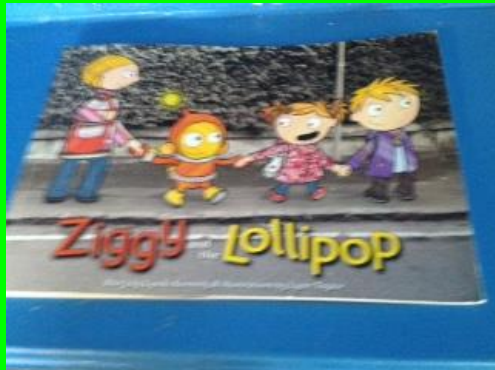
- In MACS health and safety is very important.

- *When inside we always have the choice to take part in active play, which helps us to use our physical skills and is a great way to gain 60 minutes of exercise for that day.*

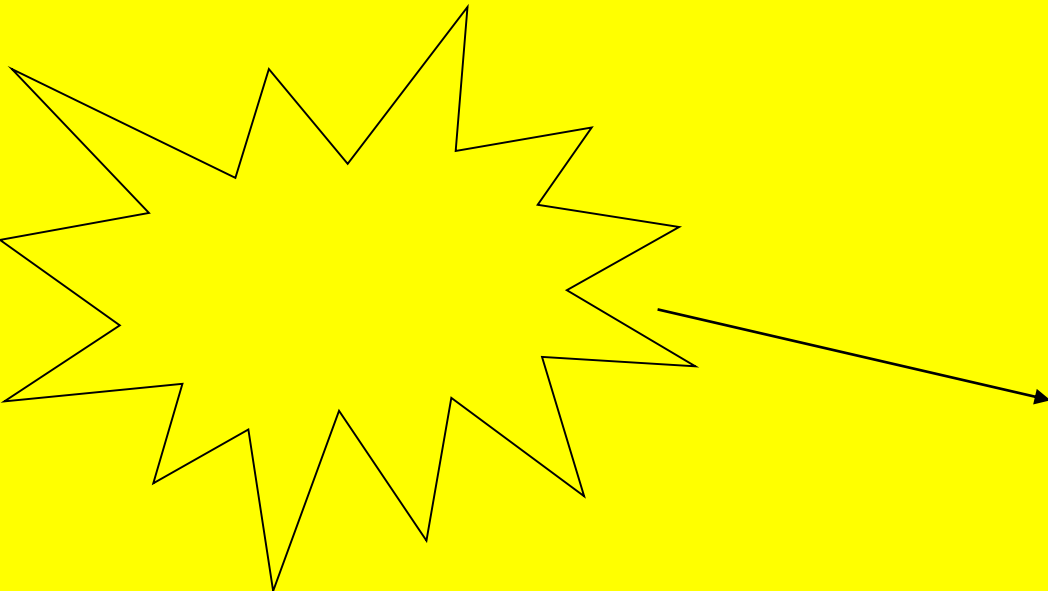
Our Workshops

Celebrating Success

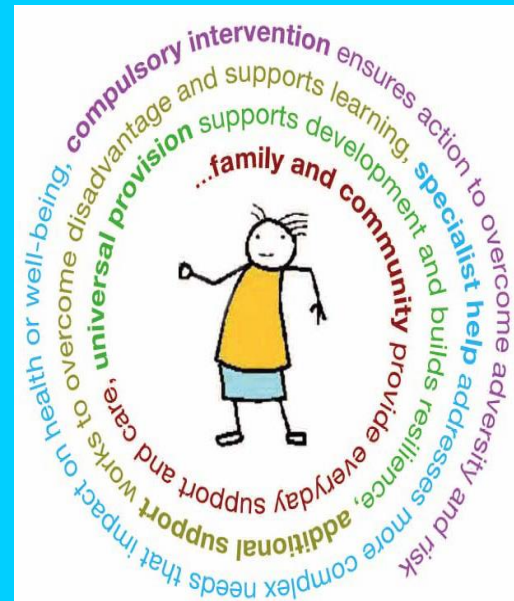
- At MACS we love to celebrate success
