### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

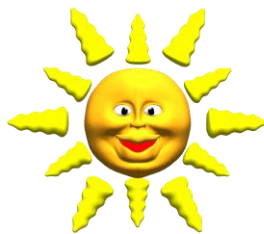
