Workshops: As part of St Cadoc's Getting It Right for Every Child (GIRFEC) strategic plan, the children have been participating in workshops. P4 – P5 participated in Road Safety where they learnt how to cross at pelican crossings and traffic lights. They also learnt what some roads signs meant.
