Breakfast

Our breakfast club opens at 7.45am each morning. Breakfast will be served from 8.00am till 8.30am so if you wish your child to have breakfast they must be in by 8.25am, this allows the toaster time to cool down. Children in P5 and upwards may play in the playground from 8.30am, so if you wish for your child to be allowed out into the playground you must sign a permission slip. If you have not yet signed a permission slip, please see a member of staff who can provide you with one. Please be aware there will be no supervision till 8.45 in this playground although the Children can come back in to the MACS room if they need any assistance. Younger Children (P1-P3) move into their playground with Staff members at around 8:50am, whilst the remaining older Children go into their playground with staff members, this gives them a chance to burn off a little energy before starting their day at School. Staff stay with the children until the teachers come to take them into school.

Monthly Planning

We have a full monthly planner created for the children which they input lots of their own ideas and suggestions. These plans are emailed to parents so they can see what the children are doing.
