#### **Project Updates**

Changes to planning: We use mind maps every month to ask for the children's interests; the children will then vote on their favourite topic for the month and staff will plan their activities around this including any festival/celebrations also happening that month.

Activity planning sheets: These are emailed out to parents to let you see what the children will be getting up to for the month ahead; this will be changing to 2 planning sheets in March as staff will start to plan activities for both older and younger children (P1-3 and P4-7). Our Floor Books are out at front desk for you to see what your children have been up to during their time at MACS.

Our Daily Board has been updated with pictures of the areas we use and what activities are available for children that day; it also states the snack on offer that day.

We have a new ECO committee: P4 will be taking part in planning meetings to discuss the design of our ECO mascot and planning activities to help us become more eco friendly.
