Breakfast Club at Crookfur – As you are aware, due to the extensive works being carried out at Crookfur for this year and until the end of term in 2017, we will update you on a regular basis of necessary information.

At this time the car park is out of bounds due to health and safety regulations from the building company. We have been advised this is a temporary arrangement, however we are hoping that we can organise a drop off time in the morning in the near future. We ask that you understand this is outwith our control at this time.

We have a very busy breakfast club this new term and on most days we have full numbers. Please remember any changes to your places at the breakfast club require a month's notice.

After-School Care Service – Due to the temporary cabins erected and change of classrooms, all our staff are on collections and bringing all the children into the dining hall for a full register check when school ends each day. The children are then given the opportunity to use the toilets and also fill their water bottles. By this time it is approx. 3.40pm. The coach is coming from Clarkston and is caught up in all local schools traffic, therefore it is not arriving at Crookfur until approx. 3.45pm and we are not arriving at Fairweather Hall until 4.00pm. This will be monitored by all staff and any further feedback passed on to all parents.

Fairweather Hall: When you collect your child/children please come to the side fire door which will have a MACS sign on the door and doorbell. The front door onto the main Barrhead Road will remain closed and is accessible for emergency exit only. Please note on a **THURSDAY** we will be using **The Edge** which is the building attached to the Fairweather Hall. The entrance to The Edge is straight from the car park.

Childrens Belongings: We will be encouraging all children to remember to bring all their belongings from class when the bells rings, as once all children are accounted for we will be heading down to the bus to take us to Fairweather Hall. Any belongings left behind by your child will need to wait until the next morning for them to retrieve. We ask that you speak to your child about their belongings and work with our staff in understanding we cannot return to classrooms.
