Breakfast Club at Crookfur – To assist parents with the possibility of adverse weather conditions, we will have 1 member of staff standing at the entrance gate to Crookfur Primary at 7.45am each morning. This will allow you at **7.45am only**, to pass your child to our staff who will then take them up to the dining hall and sign them in for yourselves. This will start from Monday 24th October.

At this time for health and safety reasons, as construction lorries continue to come in and out of Crookfur School car park, can I stress to parents that you must park in the Eastwood High School car park in the morning.

Community Facilities: We will continue to make good use of the park adjacent to Fairweather Hall, and also the Crookfur Park which the children thoroughly enjoyed. Our November Planners will be emailed out to everyone during the week of 24th October, and will show you the days we are going out to give you prior warning that we will not return until around 5.30pm. If on any of the offsite trips you do not want your children to go, please advise Carly by text or in person at our sign out desk. We want to encourage outdoor play and exploration for the children, and would ask that on damp or showery days that if you are able to let your child wear wellies or boots then they can have fun playing on the vast grassed areas.

Swimming: The numbers have been lower than anticipated, with some children forgetting their swimming things or just not wanting to go. We want to encourage this activity, but if the numbers are not sufficient then we may have to cancel this.
