Getting it Right for Every Child (GIRFEC)

Last year we introduced values around GIRFEC. This means for Mearns children staff will be working on individual care plans for each child that considers how we meet the SHANARRI Values which are Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Respected, Responsible and Included. We will continue to use play observation charts and wellbeing webs (focusing on SHANARRI values), to make sure the children's needs are being met.

We will also be chatting to the children to find out what areas they would like us to do more activities on. Our Floor Books show the activities the children have been doing each month and we would encourage you to look at these and make comments.

Last Inspection report

We had our unannounced inspection earlier last year and we are pleased to announce that out of the 8 standards inspected on, we received grade 6 excellent on six of these standards and grade 5 for the remaining two, which is really good. We are working hard to keep that standard up and do not expect to be inspected until 2016.
